- Library Conference Room, 15 - 60 people



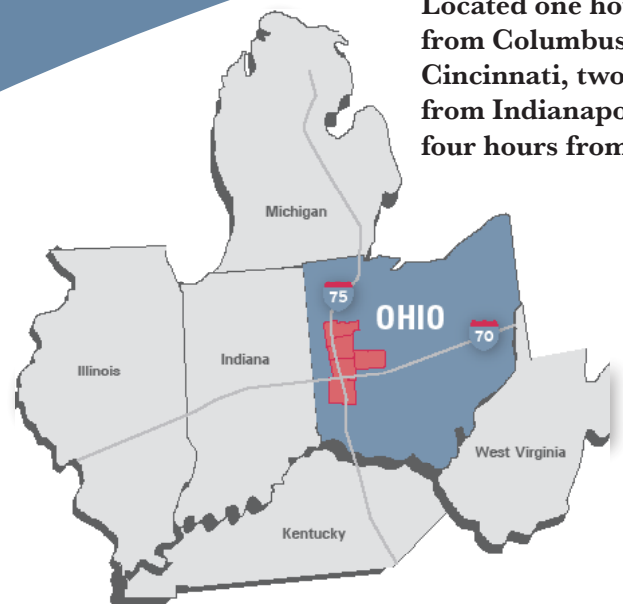

Sample Two-Day Retreat
